Parent / Guardian Authorization & Acknowledgement

I, as the parent/guardian of the above identified student, understand that my student will as part of this CTE experience be using tools, operating machines, and handling materials related to the course curriculum. Each student will be given proper instruction in the use of the equipment and all related safety procedures. As with all training, the responsibility for following the proper safety procedures ultimately must be assumed by the student. We, the staff of the Walsh Academy, place student safety as our number one priority. Therefore, we ask the students to read and sign the CTE contract acknowledging that they understand the safety procedures.

Safety Procedures

1. Student will abide by all school policies as stated in the handbook.
2. Student will follow all safety rules for working in the CTE class(es).
3. Student will follow all staff instructions while working in the CTE class(es).
4. Student will not use a tool, machine, or operate a piece of equipment without first receiving proper training from the staff.
5. Student will not use tools, machines, or operate a piece of equipment in any way other than their intended use.
6. Student will wear safety glasses at all times when working in the CTE rooms.
7. Student will wear any other safety equipment when required by the staff. (Including but not limited to gloves, aprons, and ear protection)
8. Student will wear clothing that does not create a safety concern in the CTE rooms. (Including but not limited to closed toed shoes, short sleeve shirts or long sleeve shirts that are rolled up, no jewelry, no scarves or other dangling items, and anything else that is either required by the staff, or banned by the staff)
9. Student acknowledges that CTE classes are inherently dirty (CTE classes may involve dust, glue, paint/stain, oil/grease, and other materials that may stain and damage clothing and shoes), and that it is their responsibility to wear clothing and shoes that they do not mind getting dirty, while still complying with the school dress code.
10. Student will learn the location of first aid supplies and report any injury or accident (big or small) to the staff immediately.
11. Student will ensure their actions in the CTE class(es) do not endanger themselves or others.
12. Student understands that a messy work area is unsafe and that they are responsible for cleaning up after themselves, and reporting any hazards to the staff.
13. Student understands that if they miss safety instruction due to an absence, it is their responsibility to arrange a time to meet with the CTE staff to receive that instruction prior to working in the CTE class.
14. Student understands that failure to follow safety rules and/or a failure to act safely will be grounds for their immediate withdrawal from the CTE class(es) and a failing grade in the course.
